

Transportation from Athens International Airport (ATH) to Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB)

The conference venue is the **Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB)**, located at **76 Patission Street, Athens 10434, Greece**.

We recommend either the Metro or the taxi as the preferred means of transportation.

By Metro (9 euros, one way adult ticket)

Take **Metro Line 3 (Blue Line)** from Athens International Airport towards **Dimotiko Theatro**.

1. Exit at **Monastiraki Station**.
2. Change to **Metro Line 1 (Green Line)** towards **Kifissia**.
3. Exit at **Victoria Station**, which is only two stops from **Monastiraki**. (Monastiraki → Omonia → Victoria).
4. Walk approximately 5 minutes to AUEB.

Total travel time: approximately 55–65 minutes.

As is generally advisable in any major metropolitan area, please stay alert to your belongings on the metro, especially in crowded carriages and stations.

Last Metro departure from the airport: approximately at **23:30**.

Participants arriving after 23:30 may either take a taxi or use the X95 Airport Express Bus, which operates 24 hours a day and provides a direct connection to Syntagma Square (Athens city centre). **X95 Express Bus:** €5.50 one-way.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Due to rail replacement works, from Sunday June 28 to Thursday July 2, the last train from the Airport to Dimotiko Theatro leaves at 21:10. After that, trains departing from the Airport will terminate their route at Ethniki Amyna Station. Passengers heading for the center of Athens will have to change to a bus. **We recommend checking the latest service updates before travelling:** https://www.stasy.gr/en/timetables/line-3/?utm_source=chatgpt.com

By Taxi

Taxis in Athens are yellow.

There is a set fare travelling from the Airport to the Athens city center inner ring (which includes AUEB).

- **Travel time:** approximately 35–60 minutes, depending on traffic.
- **Expected cost:** during the day shift (05:00 am – 00:00 am) the taxi ride will cost you 40 euros, while during the nighttime shift (midnight to 5 am) the taxi ride will cost you 55 euros.
