Ph.D. in STATISTICS

ANNOUNCEMENT for Applications

The Department of Statistics of the Athens University of Economics and Business has been offering a Ph.D. program in Statistics and decided on PhD candidate applications from students with an excellent MSc qualification and an interest in many areas of STATISTICS like Bayesian Statistics, Stochastic Analysis and Modelling, Financial Mathematics, Actuarial Statistics or Multivariate Statistics.

To participate in the selection process, candidates must submit the relevant Application electronically to the Secretariat of Postgraduate and Doctoral Studies of the Department of Statistics (masterst@aueb.gr) which is available at the following link: https://www.dept.aueb.gr/sites/default/files/stat/phd/Aitisi_PhD.pdf accompanied by the following supporting documents:

1. **A research proposal, including the proposed title of the doctoral dissertation and the proposed supervisor.**
2. **A copy of the bachelor's degree and an official transcript of records.**
3. **A copy of the master's degree in a relevant field and an official transcript of records.**
4. **Proof of very good knowledge of the English language, demonstrated by an appropriate language certificate.**
5. **Detailed curriculum vitae (CV), including references to any published scientific work and relevant professional experience.**
6. **At least two (2) letters of recommendation** (to be sent directly by email or submitted in a sealed envelope to the Secretariat).
7. **A statement of prioritized research interests.**
8. **Copies of relevant academic work completed during previous undergraduate and postgraduate studies.**
9. **A copy of a valid identity card (ID) or passport.**
10. **A recent passport-size photograph (colour or black-and-white).**
11. **Any additional document that the candidate considers may strengthen his/her application.**

All applications are reviewed by the Department's Ph.D. Studies Committee. The Committee may invite a candidate for an interview before making its final decision.

The final selection of doctoral candidates is made by the Department Assembly.

The following criteria are taken into account during the selection process:

1. Completion of postgraduate studies in a relevant field.
2. Academic performance in courses related to the candidate's proposed area of research.
3. The candidate's overall academic and scientific activity, including research or teaching experience, publications, participation in seminars or postgraduate courses, professional experience, and any other relevant achievements or qualifications.

Application deadline: Monday, September 14 2026
